Richmond Welcomes Discovery Owners

The Wayne County Convention and Tourism Bureau has extended a very warm welcome to Discovery owners to Richmond Indiana. In addition to a convenient location, Richmond and the surrounding area offers many interesting and exciting attractions. A sampling:

The Wayne County Historical Museum -

Discover yesteryear through the Julia Meek Gaar collection of curiosities from around the world, an authentic Egyptian mummy, pioneer life exhibits, the early automobile collection of Richmond-made cars and much more. (\$4.00)

The Gaar Mansion - Listed on the National Register of Historic Places, the Gaar Mansion was built in 1876. Complete interior/exterior restoration of this Victorian style mansion boasts hand painted ceilings, parquet floors, and features many original furnishings with their actual bill of sale. (\$4.00)

Old Richmond Historic District - This district contains more than 213 structures of historical importance. The neighborhood was first settled by members of the Society of Friends, later by free blacks and German immigrants. Today, quaint shops and restaurants are found nestled in and among the fine residential structures.

CENTERVILLE - Located just 6 miles west of Richmond is the "Antique Capital of the Nation". Webb's Antique Mall - the largest in the US. Two acres of antiques and collectibles are found in this enclosed mall. With more than 500 dealers, shoppers will enjoy a wide assortment of quality merchandise. Scott Shafer Stoneware - Pitchers, mugs, bowls, and platters are just a sampling of his quality work.

DAYTON, OHIO - Located 49 miles east of Richmond. United States Air Force Museum - "Where eagles rest". This is the world's largest and oldest military aviation museum with over 300 aircraft and missiles. Exhibits include an F-117 "Stealth Fighter", an SR-71 "Blackbird" Super Spyplane, WWI aircraft collection, and Presidential Plane Collection. (Admission free)

DISCOVERY-ING GOOD IDEAS

Rugs slipping around?

To keep throw rugs placed on carpet from shifting, use Carpet Gripper TM., from the carpet department of Home Depot and many stores.

Chilly in the toilet compartment?

Add a heat duct by removing the panel below the washer/dryer. Then chose one of the following: remove a knockout in the heat distribution box and add a twist-in flange. Cut a hole in the removed panel, install an adjustable vent, and add the appropriate length of flexible heat duct material. Replace the panel. Or, instead of creating a new hole in the heater, switch one of the ducts from the bedroom to the toilet compartment.

Need a place for maps?

Install a wooden magazine rack, available at Campers World, on the catty-cornered lower wall of the dash, near the passenger seat.

Need a place for magazines in the bedroom?

Install one or more magazine racks on the lower wall, under the window on the drivers side.

There's still ample room to walk by.

Water heater using too much propane?

Add, (or have it done for you), an electric hot water element to the water heater. Install a separate switch, and use when on shore power.


