The rally will start on Wednesday October 8<sup>th</sup>, with early arrival on Tuesday the 7<sup>th</sup>. Departure will be on Sunday October 12<sup>th</sup>. Marilyn & Jim are planning the activities which will include Golfing on Friday and a Casino Night at Ocean Downs Race Track on Saturday evening. Other details of the agenda will be sent out to you in September.

Marilyn has reserved 14 full hook up sites (Water, Electric, Sewer) for the Mason Dixons but you need to call the Fort Whaley Campground at 888-322-7717 or 410-641-9785 and make your own reservation. The rate is \$46 per night and the absolute deadline for you to make reservations is September 30<sup>th</sup>. You will be asked to provide a \$25 deposit at the time you make your reservation. Fort Whaley Campground is located in Whaleyville, Maryland, just 15 minutes west of Ocean City. Just 12 minutes away is Ocean City, Maryland with its' beautiful sandy beaches, famous boardwalk, great fishing and amusements galore.
