

POTATO WEDGES WITH ONIONS? (Serves 4)

Ingredients:

1 cup grated Parmesan Reggiano cheese
1/2 cup EVOO Olive Oil
8 Yukon Gold potatoes, cut into thick wedges
Kosher salt
1 bunch Italian parsley, finely chopped

Preparation:

Preheat oven to 400 degrees Fahrenheit Prep time: 10 mins. Total time: 20-30 minutes.

Toss together the cheese, oil and potato wedges in a large bowl.

Season with salt. and lay the potatoes out in a single layer, on a baking sheet. roast for 10-15 minutes. Turn the potatoes over and roast for 10-15 minutes more. Toss the potatoes with the parsley and serve.

Notes:

If you want, make a second mix of cheese and Evoo and use this to coat 4 medium, PARTIALLY COOKED (boiled or in the microwave) onion wedges. Cook the in the same oven as the potatoes, but on a different baking sheet (preferably rimmed to prevent any wet runoff). Halfway through cooking, turn over the potatoes and the onions. You might also trade the pan heights in the oven but be sure and add a few minutes to the cooking time.

These seasoned Parmesan potato wedges are quick and easy to make and come out perfect every time. They are great as a side, appetizer, or even as a delicious snack on their own
