One of the most important things to check is the air pressure of the tires. Best way to determine the proper air pressure is to get the "D" weighed preferably all four wheel locations (4 corners) and get the exact weight of each wheel location.

You can then check inflation charts for your tires to determine the air pressure. If you can't get four corner weights, get axle weights and inflate accordingly.

Make sure to check the fluids and top them off. I would also suggest checking the propane; you may need your furnace.

Enough of that, I'm sure you have your "TO DO" list to get going.

Our Wagon Master, Bob Deal is looking for people to suggest locations for Mason-Dixon rallies this year, please contact Bob or I so it can be set up. At our chapter Mason-Dixon meeting at Camp Discovery we will be discussing this topic and hopefully setting up a few rallies.
