Pat and Russ are looking forward to hosting the Spring 2022 Combined Chapters meeting Rally in Lancaster, PA., We have selected a number of tours and activities that highlight the Amish/German heritage and other venues of the local area. There will be plenty to do, shopping for handmade furniture and crafts, delicious homemade foods, farmer's markets, dining, theatre shows, and museums.

Our Rally will be held at Flory's Campground in Ranks, PA., beginning on Saturday, May 21st and departing on Thursday, May 26th, 2022. We have **only 15** sites set aside for us. Additional days can be reserved both pre and post rally directly through the campground. We recommend booking the campground early since the Friday after is Memorial Day weekend.

Campground reservations can be made anytime from now until the end of December directly with the campground. The campground owners will contact all registered rigs in December with a request that a deposit be made by 2/1/2022. Refunds are available up until 30 days prior for a \$10.00 fee. Rates for 2022 are: \$67.00 for 30 amps, \$70.00 for 50 amps (includes cable TV & (Wi-Fi). Discount rates available for 5+ and 10+ days. You will need to mention you are part of the Discovery Rally group when making reservations. We will have use of a pavilion for meetings and meals, refrigerator, freezer and outlets for crockpots. No cooking equipment available, and sadly no campfires.
